6.0. STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

Students are obliged to bring with them the followings:-

- (i) Bed sheets and mosquito net (for hostel residents).

7.0. TUTION FEES AND PAYABLE RULES AND REGURATIONS

- (a) It is an obligation of all students to pay their dues on time as stipulated in the joining instructions forms.
- (b) A student who fails to pay his/her dues as agreed will be discontinued from college.
- (c) All fees are calculated to cover, only student theory studies. It is the liability of the student to incur costs on practical.
- (d) Student’s fee once paid is non – refundable unless on an agreeable conditions. All fee refunds (if any) can be affected only after deduction of the necessary costs as provided by the academic committed.

8.0. CAMPUS/CLASSES RULES AND REGULATIONS

- (a) A student who does not attend classes continuously for three days without good reasons will be discontinued. Any absenteeism and permission must be communicated through the course coordinator
- (b) Students must attend all periods and be punctual for classes without missing.
- (c) Tutors will dismiss late comers and keep an attendance registers for record, and have the right to discipline any misbehaving student.
- (d) Students must wear uniforms always while in class and surrounding college areas. Failure to do so stern measures will be taken.
- (e) Students are prohibited to use filthy (bad) language around the college campus.
- (f) Strictly no shouting in class or going out without tutor’s permission.
- (g) Mobile phones are prohibited in classrooms and strictly do not litter the school environments.
- (h) Smoking is not allowed in college area.
- (i) Do not bring outsiders or relatives into the campus without order. Students’ visitors will be allowed only at lunch break.
- (j) Timetable and other information will be provided to students after payment of the first installment fee.
- (k) Institute’s property must be safeguarded, anyone caught spoiling them will be compelled to pay or repair.
- (l) Every student must learn English and French as a compulsory language.

9.0. SEMESTER AND FINAL EXAMINATION REGURATIONS

- (a) Semester examination will be done after every three months. Those who fail any subject(s) will be required to sit for supplementary at a fee of Tsh. 5,000/= for each subject. These include those who have not done the exams for any reason.
- (b) Students would be discontinued after failing for the second time, but may be allowed to start afresh in the same class.
- (c) Students who do not complete paying their school fees or follow up a payment plan as required will not be allowed to sit for their semester’s, final examinations and not allowed to go for the study tour trips.

10.0. HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

There will be short holidays during the month of March or April and December. During those holidays, the College will be closed and all hostel boarders must leave the (college campus).
